

## NORTH COUNTY

**North County Rent Range: \$300-\$1200**

*Distance: 15-20 miles north of campus*

This coastal community has a small town feel with an eclectic combination of bakeries, ethnic restaurants, clothing boutiques, and strip malls.

**Del Mar/Solana Beach Rent Range: \$410-\$900**

*Distance: 5 miles north of campus, commute may be extended during peak traffic times*

**Mira Mesa Rent Range: \$200-\$1060**
